Serving sandwiches from the trunk of our car soon progressed into getting an old school bus and outfitting it to become a mobile soup kitchen that became known as Street Connection. In the now 25 years since those early beginnings, we have had the opportunity to serve many people and in the process, watch as God faithfully provided everything that was needed. That includes the many people who have given of their time, talents and resources to help make this ministry possible.

Our vision today remains the same as it was in the beginning. We continue to help people in need – serving low income families in five communities of the HRM. The majority of those we serve are children.
