


We thank God for His faithfulness in providing for this ministry over the past year and for the many people that have given to His work of helping those in need.

Christmas Outreach 2015


We are pleased to report that our 24th annual Christmas Outreach was a success! We are thankful for the tremendous support we received from individuals, businesses, foundations, service organizations and churches. With the help of all those who contributed we were able to bring help to many families not only within the HRM but in other parts of the province as well.

In December, we were able to deliver food hampers that included a turkey to 276 families in the areas of the HRM that we regularly visit. Those locations include the 500 Block of Herring Cove Road, Bayers Westwood, Mulgrave Park, Greystone Drive and the former Scotia Court area in Dartmouth.

We also distributed hundreds of treat bags for children along with new socks, hats and mitts. We appreciate the support we received to help make this possible once again.

Also, thanks to the generous support of a group of businesses and individuals, we were once again able to expand our outreach. We were able to assist 231 families in Bridgewater and 71 in the Digby area by distributing turkey hampers in those locations. Also 40 hampers were delivered to the Mahone Bay food bank and 35 to the Lunenburg food bank.

We know from the responses we received that the Christmas assistance was greatly appreciated in all the locations we visited.
