New Bus Update!

We are very excited about the new Street Connection bus and the renewed vision we have for this ministry. Renovations to the bus are proceeding on schedule and we hope to have it completed by early spring. In the meantime the Street Connection van will be used to distribute bread and clothing to the families that we serve.



The exterior modifications to the bus are now complete. The bus has been painted white and work is underway to renovate the interior. As with the old bus, there will be an area in the front to take clothing orders, a kitchen and serving window in the mid-section, and the back section of the bus will be used for bread distribution.
